VEHICULAR MOVEMENTS – COLNE PARK ROAD AND COLNEFORD HILL, WHITE COLNE

At your recent Annual Parish Council Meeting, Robbie Jamieson advised you we would carry out the turning circle movements at the above location.

Please find attached a plan showing large vehicles making this manoeuvre. As you can see, from the attached plan this manoeuvre can be undertaken if there are no parking vehicles at or on the junction.

For this manoeuvre to be undertaken safely, all parking at this junction and just beyond will have to be removed.

If parking restrictions are implemented it will be an offence to park in front of and behind the lines. The properties along this stretch of carriageway have the ability to install a vehicular access which would help with some of the parking that is occurring on the junction and verge. The remaining vehicles parking on the verge does need investigating and perhaps stopping as the forward visibility when exiting this junction may be obstructed.

In conclusion, we are more than happy to look at putting parking restrictions at the junction of Colneford Hill and Colne Park Road and if over runs on the verge are still occurring, I am more than happy to look at other measures at that stage.

Please advise me on how you wish to proceed.


